## **Community Instructions**

Thank you for participating in the Vaccine Rewards Program from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services! Please follow these instructions to earn your rewards.

- 1. Click on the link or use the QR code provided by your home care worker. You must use this link to register, or you can have your worker help you register. You can also call an NMHA Program Navigator for assistance at 877-770-NMHA (877-770-6642)
- 2. Complete the registration form and questions. The answers to your survey questions will be used for data purposes **WITHOUT** your personal identifying information.
- 3. When you complete the registration, you will be issued login credentials of your own. PLEASE PRINT OUT THE LOGIN INSTRUCTIONS. If you can't print them out, don't worry, we will email them to you as well. You will need this to come back and record your vaccinations to get rewarded.
- 4. You will be issued a reward of \$50 for each vaccination shot you validate. Validation is done by logging back into your registration website and recording the details of each vaccination shot you receive. Here's what to do:
  - a. Log back into your registration website (community.flexforchecks.com) You will need your login credentials that you previously printed out.
  - b. Click on "Record My Vaccinations"
  - c. Upload a picture of your vaccination card. This can be done from a cell phone picture or a scan.
  - d. Enter the vaccination type (e.g., Moderna™, Pfizer™, Johnson & Johnson™).
  - e. Enter the date of the vaccination.
  - f. Enter the location of the vaccination (e.g., Walgreens $^{TM}$ ).
  - g. After validating your shot, and if you like, you can also record a short video (up to 30 seconds) to convey your vaccination story or your feelings about your new ability to check off all the new things you can do!
  - h. If you chose a two-shot vaccine, repeat these steps to be rewarded for your second shot.
  - i. You will receive a reward for each shot you verify (up to two shots).

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
